Experiencing Mennonite Marriage Encounter for Hispanics

In the year 1990, after 23 years of Marriage, the Tadeos became acquainted with Marriage Encounter. They joined a group of other couples, in PA, desiring to improve their marriages. This experience turned out to be a special turning point in their Marriage. They wished that other couples could attend a Mennonite Marriage Encounter and experience such a blessing.

The Tadeos retired from the mission field of NW Mexico after 23 years of service, and returned to the U.S. But, they did not forget the Mexican people they left behind. How could the Tadeos help the growing Mexican churches? They asked Mennonite Marriage Encounter if they would be interested in having an Encounter in NW Mexico. There was a Spanish manual available that was being used in other Latin American countries. In 1992 the Tadeos returned to NW Mexico with a team of presenters from Mennonite Marriage Encounter. Raul served as coordinator and translator for the English speaking presenters.

In the year 2000, a second Encounter was held in NW Mexico, in the states of Sinaloa and Sonora Mexico. The Mexican Mennonite churches of two states were growing and adding young couples to the congregations. Two Encounters, on two weekends, were held that year, one in Los Mochis, Sinaloa and another in Ciudad, Obregon. Again, Raul served as coordinator for the Encounter and did the translating for the English speaking presenters.

For years, Raul had desired to have a Spanish Marriage Encounter for Spanish speaking couples in the U.S. Raul was aware that there were no Encounters being held anywhere for U.S. Hispanics couples

In 2017, Raul finally saw his dream come true. A Marriage Encounter for Spanish speaking couples was held in Berlin, Ohio on May 5, 2017. But to have this Encounter the outdated Spanish manual had to be

rewritten. Could Raul rewrite the manual? Yes. The manual was ready for the 2017 Marriage Encounter. Raul served as coordinator for a Marriage Encounter, along with pastor Haroldo Nunes. This was a bilingual Encounter for couples of the Salem Mennonite church of Wooster, where both English and Spanish speaking persons attend. Raul translated for the Hispanics that attended, since the presenters only spoke English.

At the time of the 2017 Marriage Encounter, plans were already being made to have an encounter for the Mexican Mennonite churches of Sinaloa, Mexico. They have a large group young couples in their growing churches. Two couples, leaders, from the Mexican churches, Agustin and Lydia Suarez and Otoniel Doribel Soto were invited to attend the Wayne County Encounter in preparation for the Mexican Encounter which will be held the weekend of April 17-19, 2020. Haroldo Nunes will go to Mexico and serve as coordinator for the Encounter. Open Arms Hispanic Ministry will be a sponsor for the Mexico Marriage Encounter.
