After the successful 2022-23 academic year Open Arms tutoring program for Latino elementary and middle-school students in the Smithville, Orrville, and Dalton schools, we held the Sum-



mer Kid's Camp for them and others at Orrville Mennonite Church each Wednesday in June and July from 9:00 am to 2:30 p.m. The Camp, with 32 children from four to sixteen years of age and with twenty-five volunteers, was enriching and fun for all, with days filled with opportunities to keep speaking English while improving reading and writing skills, building friendships, and enjoying a variety of activities.

The younger students participated in fun language, music, and arts projects with time for play factored in, while the older students honed their reading skills and also had fun in cooking classes, drama productions



and personal-growth sessions, still with time for games and recreation. Open Arms extends a huge "thank you" for the generous time given by all our volunteers: group leaders, "reading buddies," class assistants, recreation leaders and meal and transportation providers. Kid's Camp concluded with a pool party and lunch at Camp Luz for all students, their families, and volunteers. This party was a great time of fellowship and fun for all.

Final plans are underway for the Tutoring Program's 2023-2024 academic year, with a big "Welcome" to Open Arms' new Education Coordinator, Seneca Bowers. At this point, there are twenty three students with tutors, but new referrals come in all the time. The program continues to depend on its dedicated tutors, each working one-on-one with an assigned student once or twice a week. We continue to receive new referrals for Latino students with reading or math struggles and also for students new to the area with limited or no English-language skills, so we are always looking for additional tutors.
